Update to COVID Protocol
March 24, 2023

“We wanted to update everyone regarding our Covid-19 protocols for in-person services at Allen AME Church. Although some would like us to believe the Covid-19 virus is over and does not pose a threat to our society, we know that remaining vigilant about our safety is priority #1.

We understand that some folk will never be comfortable with close human interaction without a mask or being amongst the crowd. That is okay and your choice to continue to express.

The CDC has noted Maryland as one of the lowest percentages of new and existing Covid-19 cases in the U.S. The AME Commission has recommended we stay safe but does not require patrons to be masked at all times or to maintain 6 feet of distance between one another.

We, at Allen AME Church, are giving you the choice to be masked inside our building during in-person services. It is also your choice whether you would like to come to the Altar for prayer. We will continue sanitizing our surfaces and providing PPE for those who desire.

We will no longer require persons to pre-register for in-person services starting April 02, 2023. We will continue to ask that you use the Entry and Exit doors to and from the Sanctuary. We also ask that if you do not feel well, have a fever or have contracted a virus of any kind, that you stay home. Please do not come to in-person services or meetings inside the building, as we want to maintain a clean and safe environment for all to enjoy.

We thank you for your understanding and patience as we continue to navigate what is the new normal."
